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## Scale Pattern #1

The distance between each fingering on each string stays the exact same for each scale. We are simply starting in a new place for each scale. For instance, the distance between 0 and 2 at the beginning of the A Major Scale is two frets. And, the distance between 1 and 3 at the beginning of the Bb Major Scales is also two frets. We are just taking the same sequence of fingerings and shifting it up the fingerboard.
